We love the holidays!

YMCA Y-Kidz offers a diverse range of energetic and engaging activities for children during school holidays and on INSET days.

Our holiday activity clubs are themed to build children's excitement and ensure activities regularly change throughout the academic year.

Activities typically include arts and crafts, sports and games, performing arts, food decoration, soft-play, treasure hunts and talent shows. Previous weeks have been themed around dinosaurs and going 'around the world'.

We make sure each child is up on their feet, getting stuck in and using lots of energy. Our activities encourage children to communicate and build their confidence.

Our clubs provide flexibility wherever possible with both short and full day options.

Our holiday activity club is available for 5-11 year olds. Children aged 4 years of age are more than welcome to join us for a flexible four-hour slot. To secure this space please call or email us.

Typical Day at a YMCA Y-Kidz Holiday Activity Club

We ensure that every day at our holiday activity clubs are different. A typical day would be something like this...

Lets get started

Everyone warms up when registration opens between 8am - 9.30am. We have a range of 'first thing' activities for the early birds until we do our 'all club' wide-awake warm-up at 9.30am.

Morning

This is a great time to begin making new friends during our sessions which range from our Y-Active sports, softplay or Y-Arts creative time.

Lunch

Our supervised lunchtimes from 12pm give children time to eat their packed lunches and take a bit of chill-out time before we begin the afternoon activities.

Afternoon

We begin our afternoon sessions from 1.00pm. This usually involves supervised time on the adventure playground or nature trails for the younger ones, or for those feeling more active after a warm-up, dodgeball or team challenges could be in order.

End of the Afternoon

At 3.15pm, we announce who has been our Star of the Day, we check on lost property and get ready to meet parents.

YMCA Y-Kidz Quality Assurance


YMCA Y-Kidz does not compromise when it comes to its quality standards.

- ▶ Delivery of structured, supported accommodation for over 300 people each year who are most in need. Our belief is that stable accommodation and a journey that is person centred will assist individuals in moving forward. We are proud of the positive impact we have on the lives of many young people and how we move individuals along their journey to training, employment and independent living.
- ➤ YMCA Key College through which we provide a whole host of vocational training courses, and specialist school services for young people aged 16-18 and up to 24 in some instances. Often our students have significant and complex needs and are supported by a team of highly qualified and dedicated tutors and through small class sizes, individualised student plans, flexible learning styles and relaxed environments. Students leave YMCA Key College ready for employment; we focus young minds and move them towards independence.
