PTFA Bag 2 school collection - Tuesday 15th October

This terms PTFA Bag 2 school collection is in October

Bag 2 school specialises in collecting and buying quality second-hand clothes in their original condition, which are then sold to wholesalers in emerging nations. They collect directly from the school and every kg of clothing generates 40p for the PTFA. So, the more bags that are filled, the more money is raised for the school. Each collection raises approx. £120

They collect unwanted, good quality clothing, shoes, bags, scarves, jewellery, socks, belts, soft toys, towels, bedding, curtains and linen.

Our next collection is scheduled for Tuesday 15th October

You will receive a sealed bag in your child's book bag for you to use. If you do not receive one or need more, please use black bin bags.

Filled <u>tied</u> bags can be brought to the school playground from **3.25pm on Monday 14**th **October** or by **8.55am on Tuesday 15**th **October**. Please <u>only</u> leave them underneath the shelter in the playground in case of rain, as Bag 2 school will only collect dry bags.

Please do not leave any bags outside of above dates and times, as they cannot be stored.

Items that **CANNOT** be included in the bags are;

- School uniforms with and without logo
- Duvets and blankets
- Pillows and cushions
- Carpets, rugs and mats (including bath, shower and toilet mats)
- Soiled, painted, ripped or wet clothing
- Corporate clothing and workwear
- Textile off cuts, yarns or threaded material

If you have friends or relatives that have unwanted clothing, please encourage them to fill a bag for bag 2 school.
