Make a collection of toys and instruments/noise makers. Then use the instruments to create a sound effect for each toy. Talk about the different sounds the instruments make and why they match each toy.

or rhyme, use some
instruments or noise makers to
add sound effects to the story.
Think about how different
instruments could be played to
create different effects. For example
can you make a loud noise and a
quiet noise using the same
instrument?
