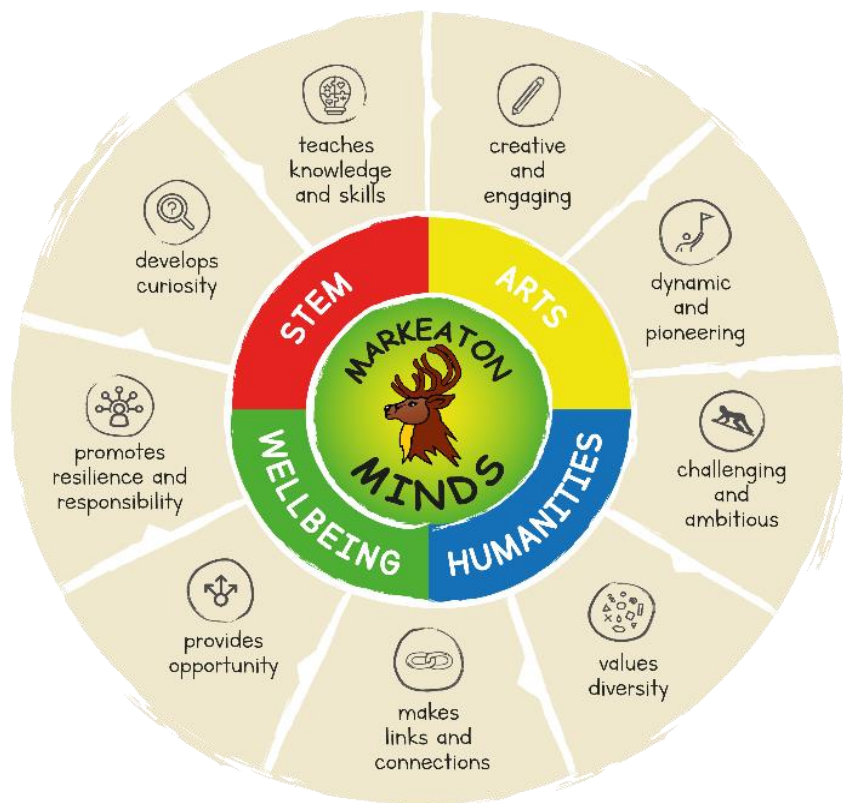
Art vision statement:
