Key Worker/Vulnerable Child Provision Information

Structure of the day

This time round there will be more of a focus on the curriculum, meaning those children that do attend will access the same remote learning as the children who are at home (including attending the morning meeting using Teams). They will be in small groups in a classroom with a Class Teacher and a Teaching Assistant. Year groups will not mix at any point throughout the day and follow the normal health and safety rules we had in place before Christmas.

School uniform

Key Worker/Vulnerable Children are expected to attend school in their uniform unless it is their day for PE (see timetable).

Lunches

Our kitchen will resume serving hot dinners for children in all year groups from Monday 22nd February. When dinners resume we'll assume your child's meal arrangements will be the same as before the January lockdown. If your child would like to change from dinners to sandwiches (or vice

versa), please email <u>admin@markeaton.derby.sch.uk</u>. Until then, we are asking all children to attend school with a packed lunch.

YMCA

We have arranged for Charlie from YMCA to come in and deliver two PE sessions per year group each week:

Mon: FS2 and Y3Tues: Y2 and Y4Wed: Y2 and Y6

Thurs: Y1, Y3, Y4 and Y5Fri: FS2 and Y1

There will be a Whole School Assembly every Monday morning (time to be confirmed) and a Gold Book Assembly every Friday 1:30pm on Microsoft Teams. This will be attended by those in school and those who are remote learning at home.
