# Guidance for parents and carers about out of school settings

This <u>guidance on the government website</u> is about situations where children from different age groups could attend the same out of school provision (such as holiday clubs).

Among other things, parents are offered advice that the setting they choose should have Covid-19 protective measures in place and that they should consider sending children to the same setting consistently to prevent mixing with multiple different groups of children. Not all settings are Ofsted registered, and there's no single body that oversees this area, so parents are advised to check for themselves what measures are in place.

#### YMCA Summer Club at Markeaton

On a similar note, planning for the YMCA Summer Club is ongoing, but decisions have been made to (1) only open to children that attend Markeaton, and (2) keep a member of YMCA staff on site all day to carry out additional cleaning.

This is a resource we've been made aware of that may be useful to parents. The document was created with the hope that it will spark conversations in homes with caregivers and children.


