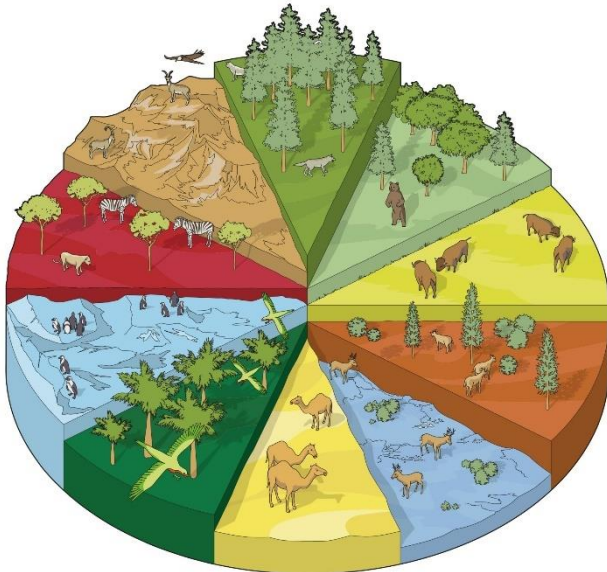


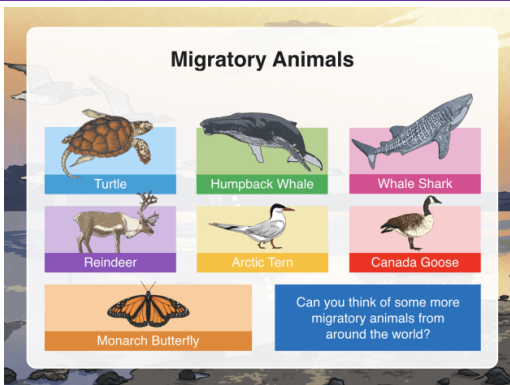
Science – Habitats



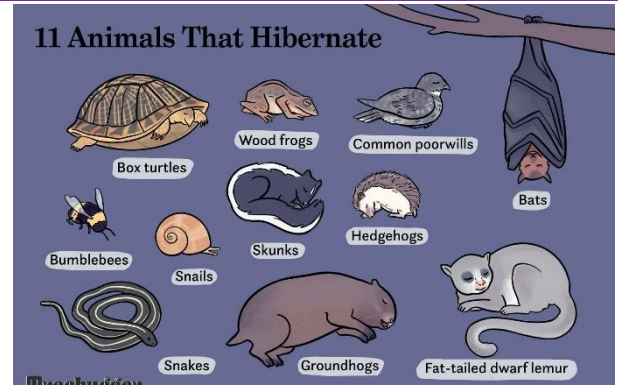
Vocabulary

Habitats	A habitat is an environment where an organism lives, and it contains all an animal needs to survive such as food and shelter.
Organism	An organism is a term for any living thing, for example, plants and animals.
Hibernation	Hibernation is a way that animals deal with the harshness of winter. They curl up in a safe place and stay there until winter ends.
Migration	A long journey to a new home is called a migration. Migrating animals go back and forth between summer and winter homes.
Seasons	In a year, there are regular changes in the weather. The four seasons are winter, spring, summer and autumn.

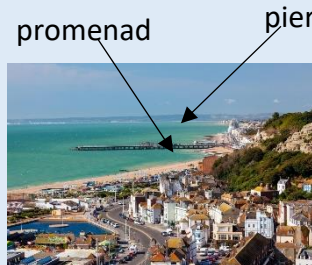
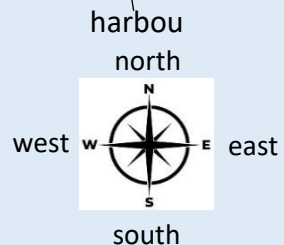
