If you're pressed for time, or can't bear the thought of waiting for the dough to dry out in the oven, you can also dry in the microwave, by placing your designs on a plate covered in kitchen roll, cooking on 30-second bursts.</p> <p>Ingredients</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 2 cups of plain flour - 1 cup of table salt - 1 cup of water <p>Method</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. In a bowl, mix together all three ingredients for the dough. 2. Knead the ingredients together on a floured surface until they form a smooth dough. 3. Roll the dough out to be roughly 1cm thick, and use cookie cutters to form the shapes that you want. Or you could make 2d/3d mini-beast shapes yourself. 4. Put your salt dough into the oven on a baking sheet on top of a sheet of baking paper, and cook on a very low heat for 3 hours, or until it has dried out completely. You can also leave to air dry for 24 hours, if you'd prefer not to use the oven at all. | <p>PSHE/Arts</p> <p>Can you design and make a board game? Could the theme be mini-beasts or plants?
