Filled tied bags can be brought to the school playground from **3.00 pm on Monday 28<sup>th</sup> March** or before **9am on Tuesday 29<sup>th</sup> March**. Please only leave them underneath the shelter in the playground in case of rain, as Bag 2 school will only collect dry bags.

Please do not leave any bags outside of above dates and times, as they cannot be stored.

The more bags that are filled, the more money is raised for the school!

Items that **CANNOT** be included in the bags are; School uniforms with and without logo / Duvets and blankets / Pillows and cushions / Carpets, rugs and mats (including bath, shower and toilet mats)/ Soiled, painted, ripped or wet clothing/ Corporate clothing and workwear /Textile off cuts, yarns or threaded material

Tickets (£2) will be on sale from Monday 28<sup>th</sup> March and every child that takes part will receive an Easter gift.

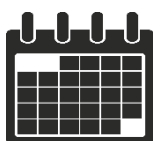
*Donations of medium size easter eggs (128 grams) would be appreciated. Donations can be made from Monday 28<sup>th</sup> March to the school office.*



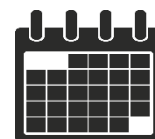
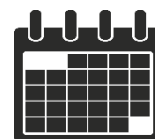
# Summer Fair Committee
