Summer Discos



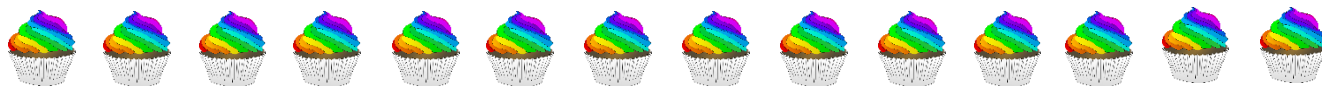
Friday 15th July

Markeaton Bake Off

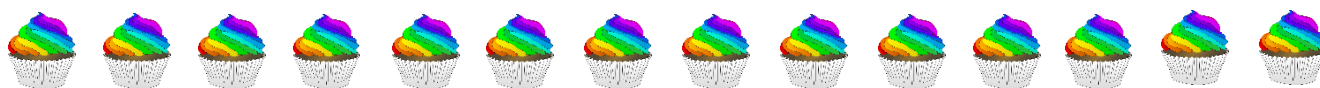
3 age categories – Infants and under / Juniors / Secondary and older

Bakes must be either cakes or biscuits

Cakes must be brought into school on Saturday 2nd July by 12pm, clearly marked with name and age category.

Judging Criteria: Each criteria scored 1-5 to give an overall score out of 20

	Cakes	Biscuits
Overall Appearance	Shape, uniform round or rectangular Decoration – original and neat A cake simply but neatly decorated will score higher than one with more complex but messy decoration	Uniform shape, identical Nor too thick or thin – characteristic of type
Internal appearance	Colour uniform Any filling even	Colour uniform No lumps Uniform holes
Texture	Not too moist or dry Even bake No soggy bottoms	Moist, not too dry
Aroma and Flavour	Delicate aroma Good pleasing flavour for type of cake	Delicate aroma Good pleasing flavour for type of biscuit
