MARKEATON PTFA MATCHBOX CHALLENGE

How many items can you fit in a matchbox?

INFANT and JUNIOR prizes for the most items collected

- 1) Collect a matchbox for £1 from the school office by Friday 14 February
- 2) Fill it with as many DIFFERENT items as you can
- 3) Write a numbered list of every item in your box
- 4) Write your name, year and class on the box and on your list
- 5) Hand your box and list into the school office by Tuesday 25 February

THE RULES

- Only one of each item is allowed (no filling the box with grains of sand!).
- No duplicates (if you put a seed of every fruit and flower it still counts as just one
 – a seed).
- We must be able to count the item. Tip: put very tiny items in between a piece of sellotape.
- No body parts (toenail clippings, bogies and hair are not wanted!).
- No living (or dead) things, including ants, spiders or beetles.
- All items must be itemised (along with the total number) on a separate piece of paper, and returned with your named box
- · Only the matchbox collected from the school office can be used
- Entries must be returned to the office by Tuesday 25 February
- · All entries must have the child's name on the matchbox and the list
- Late entries (after Tuesday 25 February) will not be accepted.
- Judges decisions are final on whether items can or cannot be allowed.
- Children are invited to decorate their matchboxes if they wish to do so. Please
 decorate them so that the judges are able to open them easily and names are
 clear.



PTFA Bag 2 school collection – Friday 14th February



We schedule a Bag 2 school collection every term

Bag 2 school specialises in collecting and buying quality second-hand clothes in their original condition, which are then sold to wholesalers in emerging nations. They collect directly from the school and every kg of clothing generates 40p for the PTFA. So, the more bags that are filled, the more money is raised for the school. Each collection raises approx. £120

They collect unwanted, good quality clothing, shoes, bags, scarves, jewellery, socks, belts, soft toys, towels, bedding, curtains and linen.

Our next collection is scheduled for Friday 14th February

You should have received a sealed bag in your child's book bag for you to use. If you do not receive one or need more, please use black bin bags.

Filled tied bags can be brought to the school playground from **3.25pm on Thursday 13th February** or by **8.55am on Friday 14th February**. Please <u>only</u> leave them underneath the shelter in the playground in case of rain, as Bag 2 school will only collect dry bags.

Please <u>do not</u> leave any bags outside of above dates and times, as they cannot be stored.

Items that **CANNOT** be included in the bags are;

- School uniforms with and without logo
- Duvets and blankets
- Pillows and cushions
- Carpets, rugs and mats (including bath, shower and toilet mats)
- Soiled, painted, ripped or wet clothing
- Corporate clothing and workwear
- Textile off cuts, yarns or threaded material

If you have friends or relatives that have unwanted clothing, please encourage them to fill a bag for bag 2 school.
