| Type | Frequency/ Duration | DUE |
|--------------|------------------------|-------------------------|
| Reading | 15 mins 5 times a week | Records* checked weekly |
| Maths | approx 20-25 mins | Friday (alternate) |
| Learning Log | 45-60 mins/fortnight. | Friday (alternate) |

* Your child may read with a family member or on their own, but their log should be signed by an adult for it to count towards the Reading Rainbow.
