• All cleaning has been moved to the
mornings to avoid contact between
staff.
• Each year group has a designated
space to have a break and/or have
their lunch to avoid crossing
bubbles.
• A reduction in the size of each year
group in order to maintain the
highest standards of health and safety.
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Where possible, staff are asked to
work remotely. This may fluctuate
given the numbers of vulnerable
children (those with SEND) who
attend school.
• All meetings held remotely
(morning briefings, department
meetings and staff meetings)
• All staff to wear a face covering
(unless exempt) around school –
this is defined as everywhere except
your classroom or designated
workspace.
• The DfE will be issuing schools with
testing kits for asymptomatic staff.
• A member of the cleaning team
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continues to be on site <u>all day</u> .

	 Additional posters around school about cleanliness and hygiene. 		
	• Face coverings to be worn by all parents/carers who drop off/collect.		
	 All children bringing packed lunches to school so kitchen not required. 		
	• No Wrap Around Care with YMCA at the moment (subject to change as the DfE have said this can continue).		
	 Reduced use of Middays at lunchtime (only need enough to cover smaller groups) 		
	• First Aid is now administered by just one member of staff who is on site all day every day. This is to reduce		
	the risk of transmission between staff and depts.
