This may fluctuate given the numbers of vulnerable children (those with SEND) who attend school.• All meetings held remotely (morning briefings, department meetings and staff meetings)• All staff to wear a face covering (unless exempt) around school – this is defined as everywhere except your classroom or designated workspace.• The DfE will be issuing schools with testing kits for asymptomatic staff.• A member of the cleaning team continues to be on site all day. | | | | |
