Ideas:

<p>People in our class do not like the fish burger option on the menu.</p>	<p>Ask your class if they like or dislike the fish burger. Take a vote and bring the decision to the next meeting. Tell your class that Mrs Stoodley has to make meals that are affordable and meet the healthy guidelines she has to follow.</p> <p>Not all classes have voted –please ask your class. Remember, it is only those who have school dinners who can vote! Mrs E to ask Mrs S about ‘Meatfree Monday’ and fish being served.</p>
<p>We are putting together an idea for a special Pyjama day for charity.</p>	<p>ONLY MRS CLAYTON’S CLASS Talk about your proposal and bring the details to the next meeting.</p> <p>To discuss next time</p>
<p>What other ‘Bees’ can we have in school? Suggestions from School Council are: Lego, Landmarks, History, Books, Maths, Space, Sports and Movies.</p>	<p>Ask your class for their ideas for our next ‘Bee’ competition. Choose a winning idea and bring it to the next School Council for discussion to take the idea to Mr Johnson.</p> <p>Suggestions collated. Mrs E will pass them to Mr J for him to choose from.</p>
