(Perhaps working with YMCA)</p> <p>Mrs E has been in touch with YMCA and is arranging an assembly with them – Date to be confirmed but as soon as she knows, we will set the PJ day.</p> <p>Assembly with Paul Taylor completed. PJ set for 24th June. Letter sent home to parents.</p>
<p>The lunch table chairs are too big and we fall off. Reps from year 5/6 said the chairs are the opposite for them – too close together and they are squashed and uncomfortable.</p>	<p>Ask your class to consider solutions that do not involve any money. Bring the ideas to the next meeting.</p> <p>Suggestions are: Swap Back to the old tables Leave a space between bigger pupils for more space Have a mixture of tables and chairs Mrs E to speak to Mr Shelton about this issue. She will report back next time.</p> <p>No further action as yet.</p>
<p>We love art and would like the chance to do more of it.</p>	<p>Remind your class that we can't just not teach other things to make room for art! What other ways can art happen? We have suggested an art club that could run for different groups of children run by teachers or parents. Ask your class if they would be interested?</p> <p>A huge amount of interest!</p>

	<p>Mrs Edge to speak to Miss Gamble about finding some parent volunteers and Art Leaders from y 5 6 to run clubs.</p> <p>No action as yet.</p>
<p>We would like to set up a book swap stop where children can bring in a book they no longer want and exchange it for another. We would also like a selection of reading books to be available at lunchtime for people to read in a quiet space.</p>	<p>We voted to action this immediately as a School Council.</p> <p>Mrs Edge is to speak to Mrs Balson / send her an e mail about these suggestions.</p>
<p>There are toilets without working locks in the upstairs boys and girls toilets.</p>	<p>Mrs Edge is to speak to Mr Shelton.</p> <p>Mr Shelton is aware of the broken locks and is looking to replace them. For now, signs saying, 'Out of order' have been stuck on the doors of the cubicles.</p> <p>Please remind your class that it is important for us to all use our More than just me skills to look after our environment.</p>
<p>The monkey bars are feeling wobbly and they squeak when you use them. The 'swingy thingy'</p>	<p>Mrs Edge to speak to Mr Shelton.</p> <p>Mr Shelton reports that they were checked at the end of March this year but he will check them again.</p> <p>He has parts on order for the swingy thingy and is waiting for them to arrive but this is taking a long time!
