Next week you will also get the chance to meet the new Eco-Council who have lots of ideas for making Markeaton greener and more sustainable. They have a section on the school website too:

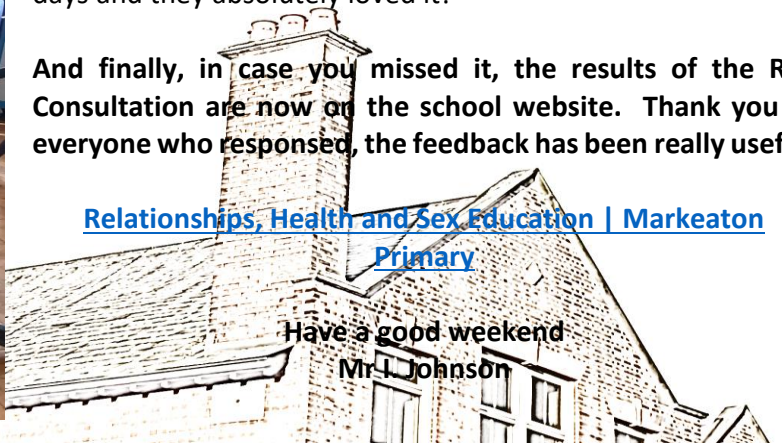
