They lined up straight after break and paid their respects to all those who have fallen in the line of duty. I know quite a few of our children are also doing parades over the weekend so good luck to them all.

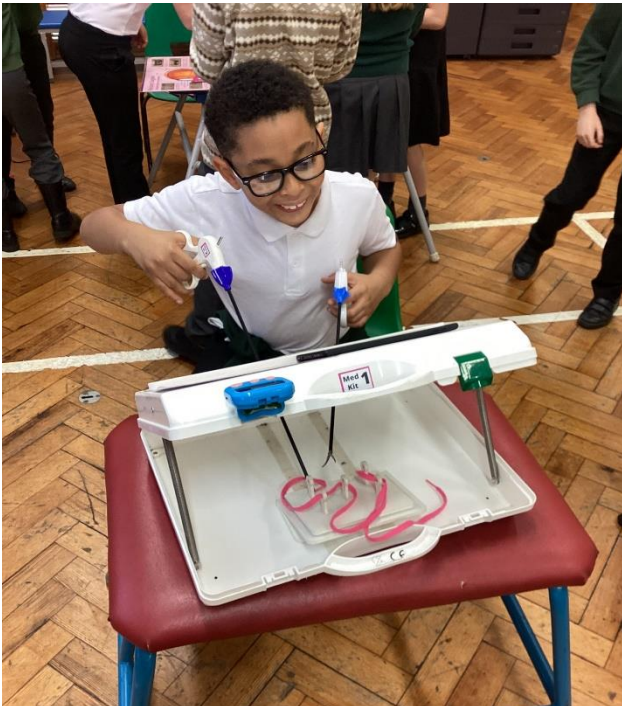
