

Even though it's been a shorter week this week, it's been no less busy!

I'm pretty sure you know what the first two photos on the left are, that's right — more Maths Manipulatives! This focus on using tactile resources to support the children's learning has had such a huge impact in lessons that the next step will be to purchase more resources for next year!

The blue rods and cubes in the first photo are called Cuisenaire Rods and the resource in the second photo is called Numicon. Both are available online and are brilliant for things like place value, number bonds to 10 and 100 and addition/subtraction.

Whilst on the subject of tactile learning, the photo in the bottom left is one of a Y6 child holding a bag of pretend blood. The children have been learning all about the human body this term in UKS2 and they have made their own blood using cereal and food dye to show what blood is made from; platelets, plasma, red/white cells etc. The children loved it and once again it shows the power and creativity in our curriculum.
