Middle left, children in Y3 have been utilising their Markeaton MINDS when sharing and editing their work. Here we have two children working really well together – top work Y3s!

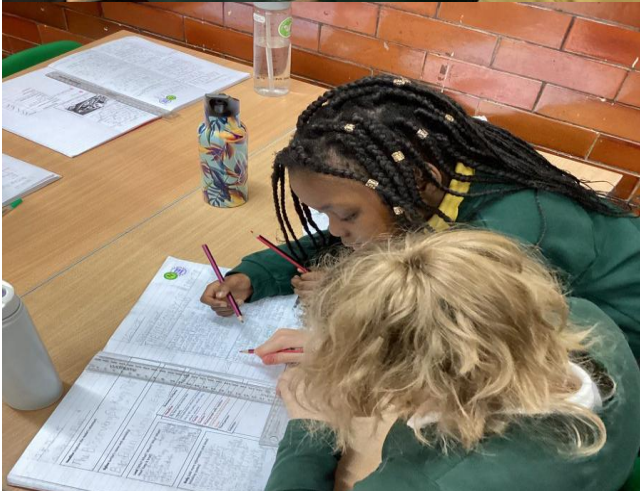
