Y3/4 'Tomb Raiders' Topic Spring Term 2025

Please also consider hat and gloves, depending on the weather.

All children need to bring with them a refillable water bottle (no glass bottles, cans or fizzy drinks please) and a packed lunch in a *small* named backpack (the children will be carrying this on their backs for the duration of the trip). Should you require a school packed lunch, please bring a small empty backpack to carry it in.
