## Y3/4 'Where's Wally Topic' - Derby Silk Mill

## Year 3 - Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> June 2025 Year 4 - Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> June 2025

As part of our Where's Wally topic this term, we have arranged a visit to Derby Silk Mill to explore one of Derby's most significant historical landmarks. During the trip, the children will engage in a multi-sensory experience; exploring the museum, using census information, photos from the past and other sources to playfully discover what life was like for children employed at Derby Silk Mill over 150 years ago. Learners will take on the role of a silk winder and make some twisted 'silk' ropes of a variety of different colours, fashionable in Georgian and Victorian times.

Children should arrive at school at normal time **8.40 am,** in their school uniform. We will be travelling to and from the venue on foot; therefore, please ensure your child is wearing sensible walking shoes, sun screen and a sun hat. Please also consider a light jacket depending on the weather.

All children need to bring with them a refillable water bottle (no glass bottles, cans or fizzy drinks please) and a packed lunch in a *small* named backpack (the children will be carrying this on their backs for the duration of the trip). Should you require a school packed lunch, please bring a small empty backpack to carry it in.
